



## Year 7 Catch-Up Premium

### Year 7 Catch-Up Premium 2015-16

In the academic year 2015-16, we identified 20 pupils eligible for the catch-up premium. This was made up from:

The amount of funding for 2015-16 was £10,000. We spent this money in a variety of ways to support progress. This included:

- Small group and one to one tuition
- Teachers offering extra intervention and support in literacy and numeracy for Year 7 pupils
- In-class support for literacy and numeracy with extra TA time allocated to support students in English and Mathematics lessons
- Reading Intervention, including through the Accelerated Reader programme
- External trips to help support and embed literacy and numeracy skills

### Year 7 Catch-Up Premium 2016-17

We have currently identified 33 pupils eligible for the catch-up premium in the academic year 2016-17. This is made up from:

The projected amount of funding for 2016-17 will be £16,500. We plan to spend this in a variety of ways, including:

- Resources to support learning
- Teachers offering extra intervention and support in literacy and numeracy for Year 7 Alpha group.
- In-class support for literacy and numeracy will take place, and extra TA time allocation to support students in English and Mathematics lessons
- Reading Intervention, including through the Accelerated Reader programme
- External trips
