ADVICE FOR SUPPORTING YOUR CHILD AT HOME

This advice is hopefully useful for all parents, but particularly those with special educational needs.

- Set a routine and get your child to be involved in the writing of it. A clear timetable will help everyone in the household.
- Provide small targets of work to complete and rewards when these are done. Consider 'banking' free time for use after school work is completed, and use a visual checklist to help.
- Get fresh air and allow movement. Encourage your child to get outside (as per government guidelines) and have some fresh air as this will help with their concentration during work.

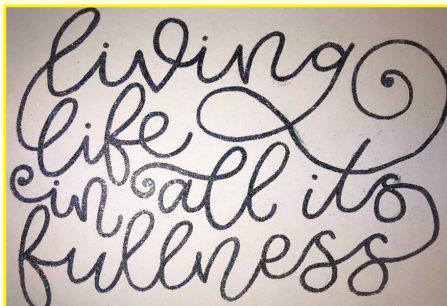
