

## **GCSE to A Level Geography – Bridging Work**

### **Tasks for aspiring A-level Geography Students over the Summer Holidays**

One of the key topics you will study at A level is the Water and Carbon Cycles.

Over the summer you are being asked to write a report of roughly 1,500 words, both on the theme “**Our Changing Landscape**”.

You should consider **how tropical rain forests are being changed by human exploitation and how this leads to changes in the water and carbon cycle**. You should locate areas of tropical rain forest; explain why they are being deforested and analyse how this impacts upon the carbon and water cycle. Where possible, you should refer to a case study. You could look at deforestation in the Borneo rain forests as a result of exploitation of the land to produce palm oil.

This report should be handed in to me by the end of the first week back.
