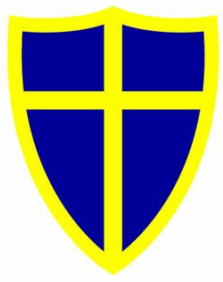

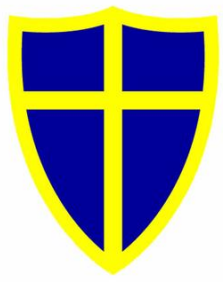
For centuries, Paris has attracted artists from around the world, arriving in the city to educate themselves and to seek inspiration from its artistic resources and galleries.

15.05 Arrival in Calais, group to proceed to European Campus Sainte Thérèse (Ouest)

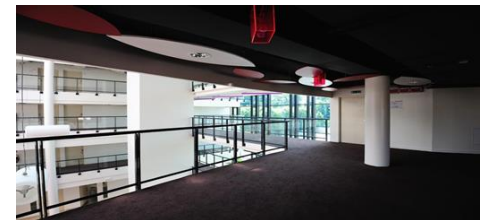
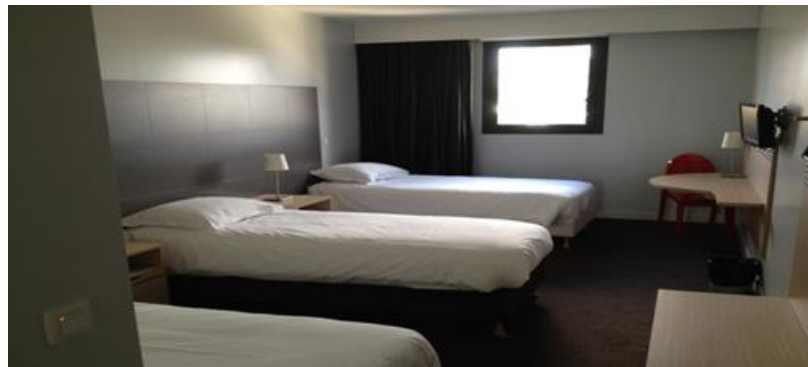
19.45 Check in at European Campus Sainte Thérèse (Ouest) for 3 nights full board accommodation. Coach use ends

20.15 Evening meal in the centre

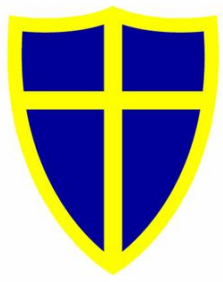
Accommodation



The accommodation at ECST Campus Ovest, Paris is safe and secure. It is a very modern and comfortable hotel which offers a high standard of room as well as good in-house facilities. It is a modern centre, built initially as a conference centre and is in safe location with excellent access to central Paris. The students will be accommodated in 3 and 4 bedded rooms with all single beds and en-suite facilities – bath/shower, toilet and washbasin. All rooms have TV and air-conditioning, towels will be provided. The centre is set in its own grounds with a football area, table tennis and there is free Wi-Fi throughout the building. Meals will be served in the on-site restaurant via a buffet self-service for breakfast and dinner. Students will receive a packed lunch every day.

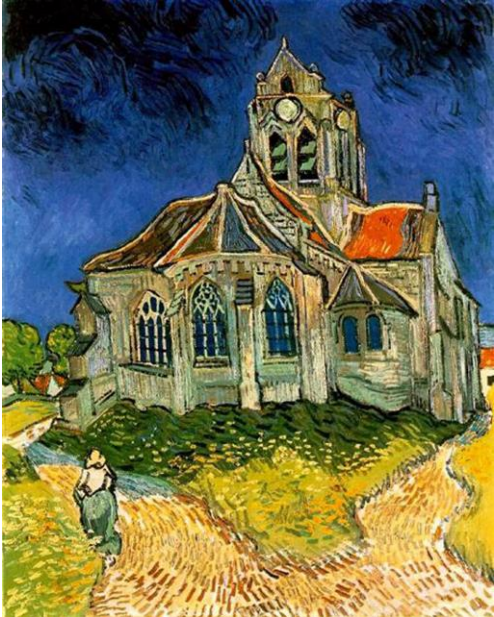

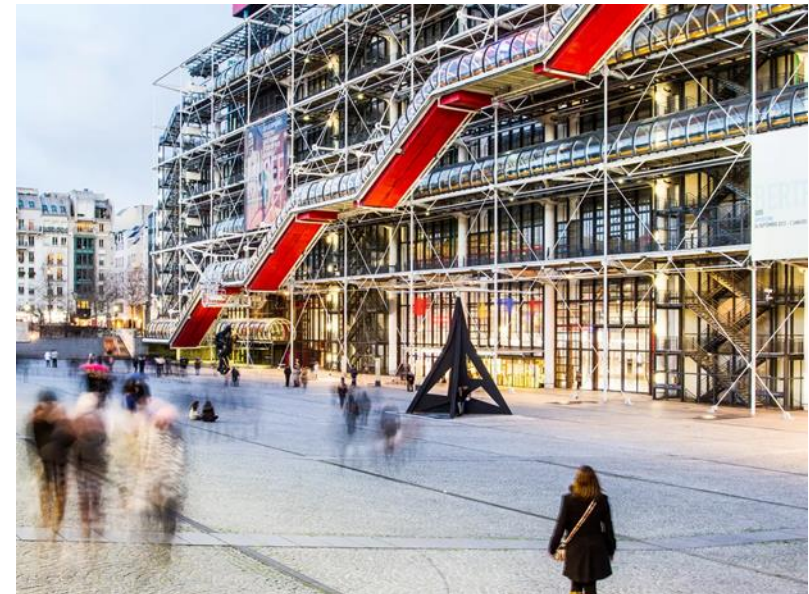

Study Visits



The Musée d'Orsay is a museum on the Left Bank of the Seine. It is housed in the former Gare d'Orsay. Famous for its vast collection of Impressionist paintings, Musée d'Orsay holds the largest number of famous paintings in the world by the painters we study — Monet, Gauguin Pissarro, Van Gogh and Renoir.

The Pompidou Centre is a complex building in the Beaubourg area of the 4th arrondissement of Paris and was designed in the style of high-tech architecture by the architectural team led by Richard Rogers. It houses 120,000 works of modern and contemporary art, the largest in Europe



Study Visits



The Louvre is the world's most-visited museum, and a historic landmark in Paris, France. It is the home of some of the best-known works of art, including the Mona Lisa and the Venus de Milo

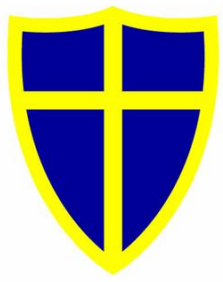


The Fondation Louis Vuitton



The Louis Vuitton Foundation is an art museum and cultural centre. The building was designed by the world renowned architect Frank Gehry and is situated in a large green space known as the Park du Bois.

The Fondation Claude Monet runs and preserves the house and gardens of Claude Monet in Giverny, France, where Monet lived and painted for 43 years. Monet was inspired by his gardens, and spent years transforming them, planting thousands of flowers.



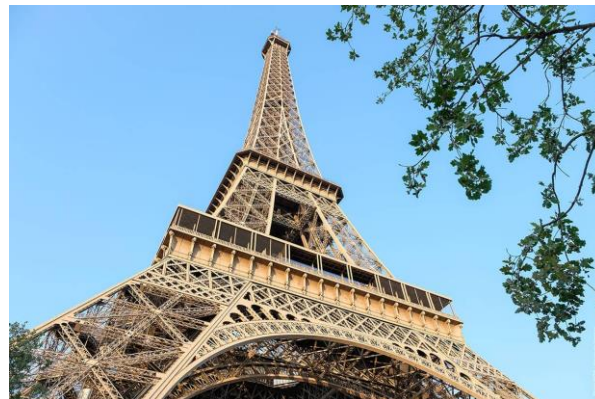

Bateaux Mouches are open excursion boats that provide visitors to Paris, France, with a view of the city from along the river Seine.

- Everything in France is expensive as we are in Paris. So I generally leave the budgeting to parents based on what you feel is a reasonable amount depending on your child.

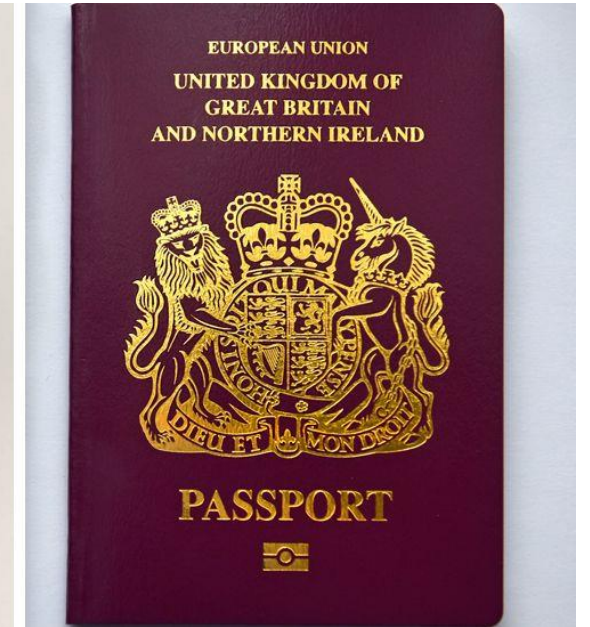
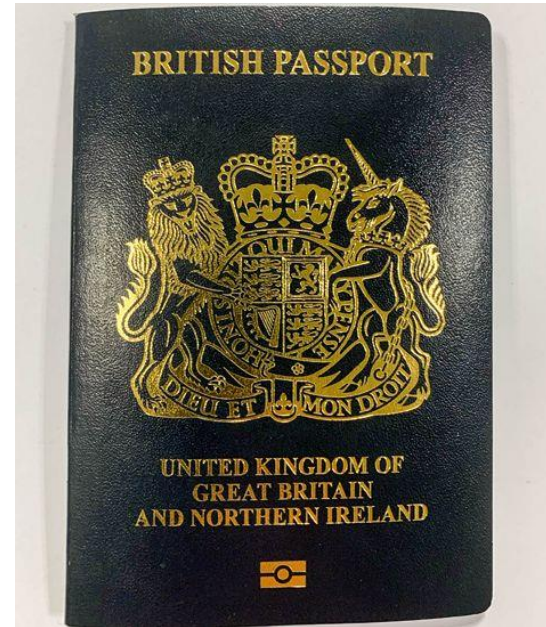

We know that you will have a lot of questions before deciding to travel post-Covid-19.
