OUR VALUES

Care - I am looking out for others

'Love the Lord your God with all your heart...and love your neighbour as yourself.' (Mark 12:29-31)

I am always growing in my understanding and awareness of myself and how my actions impact others. I demonstrate care for myself, for those around me and for the environment through the understanding of my impact upon them.

Hard Work - I am always giving my best

Whatever you do...do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God. (Colossians 3:17) Run with perseverance the race marked out. (Hebrews 12:1)

I recognise the importance of working hard to realise my given potential. I do everything with diligence and resilience, with the full knowledge of why I am doing it. I know I am designed to work and to offer my unique gifts and talents, and so whatever I do I strive to do with excellence.

Respect - I treat everyone with value

Show proper respect to everyone. (1 Peter 2:17)

As a school

We will:

- Support your child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment
- Promote and role model our school vision and CHRIST values in all that we do

- Monitor and update you on your child's progress at parent meetings and through written reports

- Promote high standards of behaviour, and outline clear expectations in our behaviour policy so we can maintain a safe environment for all children
- Set home learning that supports the delivery of the curriculum and mark it where appropriate
- Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, emails and the school website
- Respond to communications from parents in a timely manner, following school policies
- Provide good quality teaching and learning and have high expectations of all the children we teach
- Encourage your son/daughter to play a full part in the life of the school

Parents/carers

We will:

- Make sure my child attends school regularly and on time. I will notify the school if my child will be absent
- Make sure my child is dressed in the correct uniform and brings the necessary equipment to school

- Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour
- Encourage my child to try their best and follow the CHRIST values so they can reach their full potential
- Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn
- Make sure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff
- Understand that I should communicate with staff during core school hours, and although they may at times respond outside of those hours, I can't always expect that
- Make sure that my child completes any home learning on time and raises any issues with their teachers
- Read and follow the school's policies
- Treat all members of the school community with care and respect
- Engage in parent meetings and work together with the school in order to achieve the best outcomes for my child
- Read any communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary
- Support the school's mobile phone policy by using the school Reception to contact my child if necessary during the day, and by ensuring that my child accepts the consequences of using their mobile phone (and other technology such as ear pods) during the school day
